Texas pedestrians and drivers should notice streets, parks and roadways are now missing the eyesore of filthy trash, as a result of the hard work of litter-pickup volunteers on April 5<sup>th</sup>.



The Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off is the largest one-day statewide cleanup event in the U.S. and is co-sponsored by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Keep Texas Beautiful (KTB). The event brings together volunteers and Adopt-a-Highway groups from across the state who clean up their communities on one designated day.

More than 300 people volunteered locally for the Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off, collecting over 9,000 pounds of trash.

After the cleanup Brookshire Brothers provided each participating community with lunch. AB/C would like to thank Brookshire Brothers for their continued support.

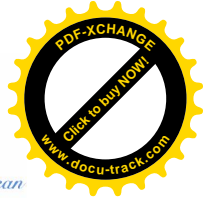

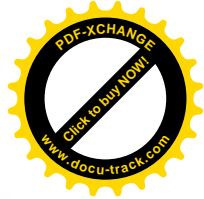
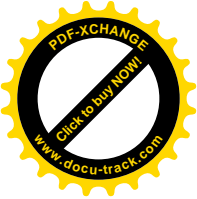
